**Your Bekaert wall covering is maintenance friendly.** You have made a wise decision in choosing Bekaert wall coverings to decorate your home. You will notice that Bekaert puts the emphasis on **quality and easy care**. The yarns we've selected provide the greatest possible advantages with regard to care and maintenance; furthermore you will enjoy your wallcovering longer thanks to the **special protector**. This treatment increases the product's impermeability to dirt and damp; any stains, which do occur, can be removed completely and effectively.

**> Keep the maintenance guide in a handy place! These tips can help you to enjoy your Bekaert wall coverings longer!**

### GENERAL TIPS

1. Treat stains as soon as possible, never let them age or penetrate.
2. Rinse with cold pure water after the treatment (not for dry soiling).
3. Dry the spot with a hairdryer. This prohibits the water to penetrate the wall covering.
4. Some stains have a persistent cause, such as cracks in the wall, moisture seeping in, etc., you would do well to eliminate such causes.
5. Vacuum-clean the wallcovering once or twice a year for a longer lifetime!

#### Maintenance tips

These products are recommended for stain removal. Always read the instructions carefully before you begin!

#### Textile stain removers

Available from: *chemist, painter, and supermarket.*

For both normal and stubborn stains (ballpoint pen, felt pen, marker), you sometimes need to sprinkle or dab the stain with an absorbent towel.

#### Stain solvents

Available from *chemist, supermarket.*

Products with which heavily soiled laundry is treated before the main wash.

#### Gomnet

Available from *Bekaert, your specialist.*

This is a cloth which is highly suitable for the removal of dry stains (e.g. around switches).

#### Biological washpowders

For ordinary stains : luke-warm water (30°C/86°F) with a biologically active detergent (5 grams per litre).

#### Diluted trichloroethylene

Available from *chemist, supermarket.*

For removing oil grease stains from dark.

<b>Beer</b>	- biological washpowder
<b>Blood</b>	- textile stain remover for blood
<b>Polishing wax</b>	- textile stain remover for candle grease
<b>Butter/oil</b>	- diluted trichloroethylene
<b>Chocolate</b>	- biological washpowder
<b>Coke</b>	- biological washpowder
<b>Cream</b>	- diluted trichloroethylene
<b>Grass, flowers, plants</b>	- textile stain remover for fruits
<b>Ketchup</b>	- textile stain remover sauce, ketchup
<b>Coffee</b>	- textile stain remover for coffee & tea
<b>Adhesive</b>	- solvent mentioned on the packaging of the product
<b>Make-up</b>	- textile stain remover make-up
<b>Mayonnaise</b>	- diluted trichloroethylene
<b>Perspiration</b>	- gomnet
<b>Grease</b>	- diluted trichloroethylene
<b>Shoe polish</b>	- textile stain remover for oil and grease
<b>Shoe sole marks</b>	- gomnet
<b>Dust</b>	- gomnet
<b>Felt pen</b>	- textile stain remover for felt pen
<b>Wine</b>	- textile stain remover for fruits and red wine
<b>Pencil</b>	- white eraser
<b>Mustard</b>	- textile stain remover for sauce, ketchup
